### SERVICE AGREEMENT

The City of Bronte is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution which could result from improper plumbing practices. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the plumbing restrictions which are in place to provide this procreation. The utility enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and welfare. Each customer must sign this agreement before the City of Bronte will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not re-establish service unless it has a signed copy of this agreement.

### PLUMBING RESTRICTIONS

The following undesirable plumbing practices are prohibited by State regulations:

- No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an air gap or an appropriate backflow prevention device.
- No cross connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the installation of an airgap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
- No connection which allows water to be returned to the public drinking water supply is permitted.
- No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
- No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead can be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
- The City of Bronte Water System will maintain the original signed agreement as long as the Customer and/or the premises is connected to the Water System.
  - The Customer shall allow his property to be inspected for possible cross-connections and other potential contamination hazards. These inspections shall be conducted by the Water System or its designated agent prior to initiating new water service; when there is reason to believe that cross-connections or other potential contamination hazards exist; or after any major changes to the private water distribution facilities. The inspections shall be conducted during the Water System's normal business hours.
- The Water System shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross connection or other potential contamination hazard which has been identified during the initial inspection or the periodic re-inspection.
- The Customer shall, at his expense, professionally install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the Water System. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the Water System.
- SERVICE AGREEMENT
- The following are the terms of the service agreement between the City of Bronte and
- The Water System will maintain the original agreement as long as the Customer and/or the premises is connected to the Water System.
- The customer shall allow his/her property to be inspected for possible cross-connections and other unacceptable plumbing practices. These inspections shall be conducted by the Water System or its designed agent prior to initiating services and periodically thereafter. The inspections shall be conducted during the Water System's normal business hours.
- The Water System shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-connection or other unacceptable plumbing practices which has been identified during the initial inspection of the periodic re-inspection.
- The Customer shall immediately correct any unacceptable plumbing practice on this premise.
- The Customer shall, at his/her expense, professionally install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the Water System. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the Water System.
- The City reserves the right to require payment of all unpaid utility bills and any otheroutstanding debt owed to the City prior to the time that such connection is made.
- Water bills are due on or before the tenth (10) day of each month (the "due date"). If payment of any bill is not made by the due date, the city may add a late charge of 10% of the unpaid bills, charges, and expenses.

## **ENFORCEMENT**

If the customer fails to comply with the terms of the Service Agreement, the Water System shall, at its option, either terminate service or professionally install, test, and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device to the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of this agreement shall be billed to the Customer.
